

# Pony Rules 2024

- Mounds:
  - NO METAL CLEATS. Turf shoes or molded cleats.
  - Home team takes care of the mounds.
- Bats:
  - 34 inch length max.
  - USA or BBCOR .5 only.
  - 2<sup>5</sup>/<sub>8</sub> barrel.
  - Automatic out if illegal bat.
  - Wood bats fine.
- Batting order:
  - Pullman batting full roster. One team has 9 and one has 10.
  - Everyone batting full lineup. But don't have to roster all of your players.
- Run limit per inning:
  - 10 runs per inning, 7th inning unlimited.
  - Mercy rule for up by 15 at 4th or 10 at 5th inning.
- Time limit:
  - 2 hours, no new inning. No drop dead.
  - Double headers - 1:45 no new inning
- Pitch rules:
  - Little League Rules. 14 and under.
    - 1-20 = 0 days rest
    - 21-35 = 1 day rest
    - 36-50 = 2 days rest
    - 51-65 = 3 days rest
    - 66+ = 4 days rest
    - Capped at 95
  - Finish the batter
- Sliding:
  - No must slide rule but have to try to avoid the tag.
  - Can't run people over.
  - Head or feet first.
- Courtesy runners:
  - For catchers and pitchers with 2 outs.
  - Whoever got the last out is the pinch runner.

- Balks:
  - Umpire discretion. Ideally talk to them on the first one.
- Mound visits:
  - Second visit you have to take out the pitcher.
- Jewelry/sunglasses for pitcher. White sleeves. White glove. - League rule. Umpire discretion.
- If kid has to leave, he can leave. Not an out.
- If kid shows up late, just stick him to the bottom of the lineup.
- Lead offs are fine.
- Play each kid at least 3 innings. Coach discretion.
